# SMART Notebook™ Training (Beginner)

This is an introductory course designed to help educators learn how to create lesson pages in SMART Notebook collaborative learning software. During this session, you'll build a simple lesson activity to use with the SMART Board® interactive whiteboard in your classroom.

In this course you'll learn how to:

- Use SMART Notebook software and the SMART Board interactive whiteboard to write and work with notes
- Create and combine SMART Notebook objects by adding text and images to the page
- Use simple techniques to create engaging, interactive lesson activities

## Who should attend?

K–12 educators and higher education instructors whose classrooms are equipped with SMART Board interactive whiteboards, but who have limited experience using SMART Notebook software to create lessons.

**NOTE:** Confident use of a Windows® or Mac® computer is required for this session.

## What can I expect?

An interactive, hands-on learning experience that's available in several formats for your convenience. Both the face-to-face and distance education sessions are led by a highly knowledgeable SMART training specialist who will guide you towards confident use of the software.
