- Build interactive lesson activities more effectively and efficiently
- Integrate rich media such as sound, animation and the Internet
- Enhance the way you present lessons on an interactive whiteboard

Who should attend?

K–12 educators and higher education instructors whose classrooms are equipped with SMART Board interactive whiteboards and who have experience using SMART Notebook software to create lessons.
