
This guide provides an overview of the information you need to begin using Whiteboard mode with the SMART Hub VE220.

In this lesson you will learn how to:

- Create a new Whiteboard file
- Write notes in Whiteboard mode
- Save your Whiteboard file
- E-mail your Whiteboard file

# Use Whiteboard Mode with the SMART Hub VE220

The SMART Hub VE220 allows you to capture notes and drawings in digital ink on your SMART interactive product. In *Whiteboard* mode, you can brainstorm, take notes, and conduct other activities using your SMART product's digital ink tools without connecting to a computer.



#### To access Whiteboard mode:

Press the **Whiteboard** button on the sidebar.

#### To create a new Whiteboard file:


Press the **New File** button on the Whiteboard toolbar.

### **Creating Notes in Whiteboard Mode**

- Pick up a pen tool from your SMART product's **pen** tray or press the **Pen** button on the sidebar and write in the drawing area
- To add a blank page, press the Add Page button and on the Whiteboard toolbar
- To delete a page from the Page Sorter, select it and press the **Delete Page** button on the Whiteboard toolbar

### Saving Your Whiteboard File

- 1. Connect a USB storage device to the SMART Hub VE220
- **2.** Press the **Save** button 🖪 on the Whiteboard toolbar. The *Save* dialog box appears.



- 3. Select the USB storage device's drive letter from the USB Drives list
- **4.** Browse to the folder where you want to save the file in the folder box

**Tip:** Create a new folder for the file by pressing the **New File** button in the top-right corner of the *Save* dialog box.

- **5.** Type a file name in the **File name** box
- **6.** Select a file type from the **Save as type** drop-down menu:
  - Whiteboard File (.notebook)
  - JPEG Archive (.zip)
  - Portable Document Format (.pdf)

**Tip:** If you select JPEG Archive (.zip), the SMART Hub VE220 saves each page in the Whiteboard file as separate JPEG image files and compresses them into one folder.

**7.** Press **Save**

## E-mailing Your Whiteboard File

1. Press the **E-mail** button on the Whiteboard toolbar. The *E-mail* dialog box appears.



- Select a recipient from the **Recipient** list or type the recipient's e-mail address in the **E-mail address** box
- **3.** Type a file name in the **File name** box
- **4.** Select a file type from the **Save as type** drop-down menu:
  - Whiteboard File (.notebook)
  - JPEG Archive (.zip)
  - Portable Document Format (.pdf)
- 5. Press Send E-mail

**Note:** To e-mail Whiteboard files, the SMART Hub VE220 requires a network connection and configuration to an e-mail server.
