What is Lumio?

Sign-in to Lumio using your Google or Microsoft account.

Explore Resources

Explore the Lumio Library, search for an existing resource, and save to your My Library.



Combine Existing Resources

[•] "Mash-Up" existing resources by importing a PDF, Google Slides, PowerPoint, or SMART Notebook file you already have.



Game-Based Activities

Create a game-based activity to help students practice a skill or strategy.



Ready-Made Activities & Collaboration

 Add a ready-made Graphic Organizer to a Lumio lesson.
Convert the graphic organizer to a Whole-Class Whiteboard or Group Workspace.



Check for Understanding

- Create an assessment using Response.
- Add a ready-made question and reflection activity to check student understanding of a topic or concept being taught.



Connect Student Devices

Start a lesson from your My Library in Lumio and get students connected.



Share with Teachers

- Share an individual Lumio lesson with a colleague.
- Create a Shared Library and add colleagues for easy collaboration. *Available with a <u>Lumio Spark subscription</u>

Activate the 4 C's Checklist

Use the checklist to enhance your lesson, keeping the 4 C's In mind. Communication - Collaboration - Creativity - Critical Thinking



Communication

- Add AUDIO for instructions
- Add a YOUTUBE clip to build curiosity
- Create a SHOUT IT OUT activity to brainstorm or check in
- Use a WHOLE-CLASS WHITEBOARD

Collaboration

- Convert a page to a **GROUP WORKSPACE**
- Add a **RANK ORDER** as a Think-Pair-Share activity
- Create a MONSTER or TEAM Quiz activity
- Convert a page to an INDIVIDUAL HANDOUT



Creativity

- Give students a **NEW BLANK PAGE**
- Add a MAKING WORDS activity
- Create a choice board with FLIP OUT or LABEL REVEAL
- Add a blank GRAPHIC ORGANIZER

Critical Thinking



- Add a RESPONSE as a formative assessment
- Add a 3-2-1 QUESTION/REFLECTION
- Create a **SUPER SORT** without category titles
- Add a WORD SEARCH with words hidden
